

District-Provided Access to Electronic Information, Services, and Networks

(APPROPRIATE USE OF ELECTRONIC INFORMATION SERVICES)

The use of the district's Electronic Information Services, including the Internet and electronic mail, by students is a privilege. Inappropriate use will result in cancellation of these privileges and may result in disciplinary action. Additionally, if inappropriate use violates the law, appropriate law enforcement entities will be notified.

Students who use the District's Electronic Information Services should not expect that communications or information sent, retrieved or stored via EIS will be private. The District has the right to review all files and communications and monitor system utilizations at any time without notice or permission. The District may close accounts and review and delete files at any time.

Students using Electronic Information Services must strictly adhere to all user requirements set forth in Governing Board Policy #3612.
