ARRIVING

We will be utilizing our normal drop off and pick up areas, as well as the regular bus parking space. Bus and parent drop off times will begin at 7:50 a.m to accommodate an organized entry into each building.

After dismissal, students will wait by family in pick up areas or load buses to assigned seats.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING THE SCHOOL DAY FOR: ON-SITE INSTRUCTION

Students will stay in their homeroom cohort, with minimal mixing. It is likely over time there will be a mixing within the classroom, however, we will limit the mixing of classrooms.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Will online learning be available if we decide to keep our child home?

A: Remote learning will be an option. The options vary depending on the governor's phases. Please refer to the opening plans presented by schools in the Flathead.

Q: Will we be notified if there is a case of COVID in the school even if our child was not in contact with that child or person?

A: Schools will inform the public, but the personal information of the student is protected by privacy laws.

Q: Will the school close if there is one case of COVID?

A: Maybe. Flathead County Health will connect with the close contacts of that person and follow the guidelines on their website with regard to quarantine time and procedures. We will work as quickly as possible to identify all the close contacts before bringing students back on campus. If we have to close school to allow time for contacting close contacts we will. Q: Will the kids still be allowed recess?

A: Yes, we are planning on recess. Recess will be conducted in small groups and likely limited to single classrooms.

Q: Will the kids have to wear masks in the classrooms?

A: Yes, masks were mandated by the Governor's Office on August 12th.

Q: Will elementary students still have music, pe, etc?

A: We are attempting to continue to provide specials for all grade levels, with precautions and procedures to ensure safety. Some specials teachers may travel to classrooms where other specials may take place in their regular rooms after cleaning has been completed.
